# **Poly TC8 Touch Panel**

Press the touch panel to wake the system from sleep mode



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#### **1.** Joining the meeting

- From the calendar view, press the Join button to join the meeting
- 2. Mute the microphone when you are not talking
  - The microphones are sensitive, this way you avoid disturbing sounds during the conference

## 3. Disconnect when the meeting ends

 Press End Call button from the touch panel to end the call



#### **M.** Content sharing

- Connect HDMI cable to share the content
- **Disconnet the HDMI cable** to end the sharing

**NOTE.** When a video conference is in progress, do not connect the USB cable of the conference device to the workstation. The USB cable is only used when playing on a computer (Device Mode function, instructions on the back).

## Using the room video system in the "Device Mode"

**Device Mode** enables you to use the room video system's camera, speaker, microphone, and connected monitors from your computer.



- 1. Activate Device Mode function
  - Press the Device Mode button in the touch panel
- 2. Connect the cables
  - Connect USB and HDMI cables to your computer
- 3. Check the audio and video settings from your video conferencing application
  - Select Poly room video system to your audio and video device inside the application.

#### 4. Start the conference from your video conference application
